## **RE: OFSTED MATERIAL CHANGE INSPECTION OUTCOME – APPROVAL TO INCREASE CAPACITY TO 90 LEARNERS**

Dear Parents, Carers, Staff, Governors, Colleagues and Local Authority Partners,

I am delighted to now be able to share the report from our most recent Ofsted material change inspection, which took place on 18 March 2026 at ALP Nuneaton.

Following the inspection, Ofsted confirmed that:

*“The school is likely to meet the relevant independent school standards if the material change relating to the school provision is implemented.”*

This outcome supports our application to increase the registered capacity of the school from 70 to 90 learners.

This is a significant milestone for ALP Nuneaton and recognises not only the school’s readiness for growth, but also the careful and measured approach being taken to ensure that quality remains at the heart of every decision. Inspectors also recognised the school’s strong leadership culture, stating:

*“All leaders, including the proprietor body, share a strong moral purpose for the school.”*

and

*“Leaders prioritise the safety, wellbeing and best interests of all pupils.”*

Safeguarding was identified as a clear strength of the school, with inspectors commenting that:

*“There is a clear culture of safeguarding across the school.”*

The report also recognised the strength of our relationships with local authorities and external professionals, noting:

*“The school has established strong working relationships with the various local authorities’ children’s services and safeguarding teams.”*

Alongside leadership and safeguarding, the inspection highlighted the quality of the learning environment and wider provision available to learners. Ofsted recognised that:

*“The school site is well presented and tidy.”*

and that:

*“The external school grounds are well maintained and provide adequate space for physical education and social play.”*

As we grow, our priority remains maintaining the high standards, relationships and personalised support that define ALP Nuneaton and, as part of this next phase, we will continue to invest significantly into:

- the recruitment and development of skilled staff
- therapeutic and wellbeing provision
- the school environment and facilities
- leadership and operational capacity
- resources that support high-quality teaching and learning

I would personally like to thank our staff team for their relentless commitment to our learners and families, our parents and carers for their trust and support, and our local authority colleagues for the collaborative relationships we continue to build together.
